



Client Instructions for Scanning & Coring

In order to enable us to carry out our services as efficiently as possible please ensure that you follow the below instructions prior to our arrival on site.

General

- Provide contact details for any site manager or equivalent present on site for the duration.

Xradar Concrete Scanning

- Arrange site access including a local vehicle parking stall for use throughout the project.
- Confirm whether or not there are post-tensioned cables in the slab.
- Layout area(s) required to be scanned, clearly marked on surface prior to our arrival.
- Arrange for carpet, membrane and insulation removal to allow our technicians direct access to the bare concrete slab/wall for a minimum area of 3' x 3'.
- Arrange for removal of standing water from the surface of the slab/wall. Please note that we will not be able to scan where there is standing water on the surface of the slab due to interference with the Xradar.
- Arrange for access to both sides of the slab/wall including the provision of ladders or rolling scaffolding where necessary to reach the other side of the slab.
- Provide a floor plan layout or similar if a CAD drawing or report is required.

Coring

- Arrange site access including a local vehicle parking stall which accommodates a vehicle over 7ft in height for use throughout the project.
- Ensure that each of the core locations has been scanned by Xradar and in the event a location has been given a black boundary after being scanned please complete the relevant checklist / approval form provided by the technician. **We reserve the right not to core until a completed checklist has been received and approved by Xradar.**
- Confirm whether or not there are post-tensioned cables in the slab.
- Layout location of cores, the centre of the core clearly marked with a black '+' on the surface prior to our arrival.
- Provide local 20Amp, 110V power source or obtain permission to run a generator during working hours and provide generator parking within 100' of the coring location
- Provide a local water source.
- Obtain necessary permission for noise creation.
- Clear area below slab and provide access and a safe working platform to other side of slab/wall.

Cutting

- Layout area to be cut, boundaries clearly marked on the surface prior to our arrival.
- Provide two local parking spots for the duration of the work.
- Obtain permission to run a generator during working hours and provide generator parking within 100' of cutting area.
- Attain necessary permission for noise creation.
